

How to apply for an Accident Tow Truck Trainee Permit

To be able to drive an accident tow truck, you must be accredited.

If you are new to the tow truck industry, it can be helpful to obtain an Accident Tow Truck Trainee Permit before applying for an Accident Tow Truck Accreditation. This provides you with the opportunity to experience the requirements of an accident tow truck driver (for example, attending an accident scene, securing a damaged vehicle to a tow truck; salvage; cleaning up debris, etc) while under the supervision of an experienced and accredited Tow Truck Driver.

To obtain the permit, you must apply to VicRoads. VicRoads will assess your application in accordance with the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007* and *Accident Towing Regulations 2019*.

The permit is valid for 60 days from the date of issue.

To apply for a permit, you must submit the following documents to VicRoads in support of your application.

Application Form

Complete and sign the Accident Tow Truck Trainee Permit Form. Please complete every question on the form thoroughly. This will help VicRoads to assess your application and process it more quickly.

Passport Photos and Proof of Identification

To enable VicRoads to process your application, two passport-sized photographs of you, and a copy of your driver's licence are required. The passport-sized photographs must be:

- no more than six months old, dated and signed by the photographer; and
 - on a plain, light coloured background; and
 - an acceptable likeness to you; and
 - a full front view of your head and shoulders, without any head covering or tinted glasses.
- If you normally wear prescription glasses, you should wear them for your photograph.

VicRoads will only accept a photograph that shows all your facial features.

A copy of your driver's licence is required as proof of identification.

Submit Application

A non refundable application fee is payable to VicRoads. This fee is for processing your application. If you are successful you will be issued with an Accident Tow Truck Trainee Permit for 60 days. You need to download this form and fill in the correct sections. The form will need to be uploaded to vicroads.vic.gov.au/tow-truck-upload, along with the supporting documentation to support your exemption application. You will have to pay a fee when you submit your documents. Once the application is submitted, you will receive a confirmation email from VicRoads.

National Police Certificate

A current National Police Certificate issued within the last six months is required. You can go to the Victoria Police website police.vic.gov.au to order the National Police Certificate, or you can use an online provider, who has been accredited by the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC). Certificates may take up to ten working days and the original certificate must be sent to VicRoads with your application. .

Privacy Statement

VicRoads is committed to protecting your privacy by fully meeting its responsibilities under the *Road Safety Act 1986*, *Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014* and the *Health Records Act 2001*. All personal information you provide will be handled in accordance with these requirements. The collection of information on this form is required by the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*. Information held by VicRoads may be disclosed to various organisations, including the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal and Victoria Police, in order to carry out their duties under the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*.
